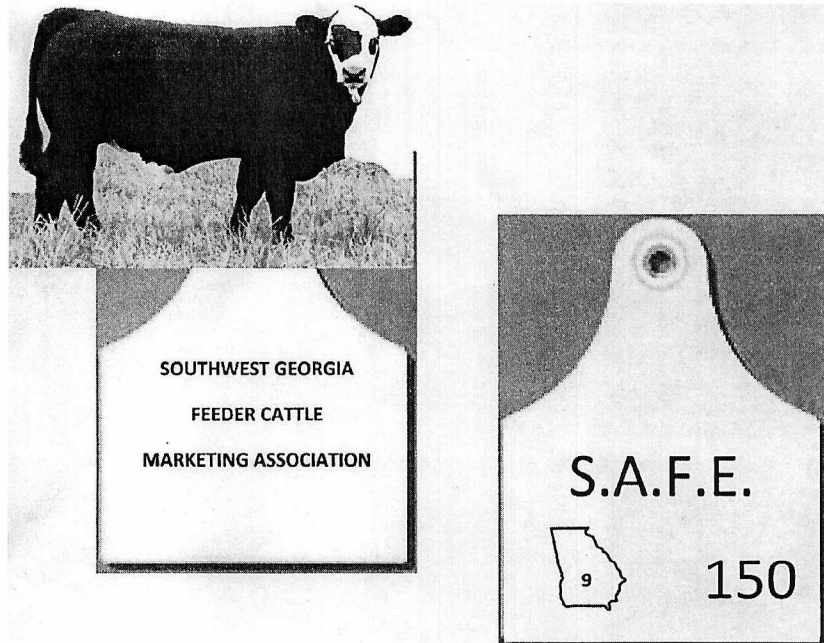

General Information, Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Consignors must follow the health regimens found in the "AL-VAC" or "GA-VAC" health program. Each consignor will provide a copy of his completed "AL-VAC" or "GA-VAC" health sheet to the buyer of his cattle. Consignors will provide health certificates as needed.
2. The Southeast Alabama and Southwest Georgia Feeder Cattle Marketing Association (S.A.F.E.) assigns to each consignor, a specific farm number to source verify these cattle.
3. The board auction location is the Early County Ag Center at 14415 Magnolia Street in Blakely, Georgia. The auction begins at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on Tuesday, October 26, 2021.
4. Mr. John Moseley, Jr. will assist both the Southeast Alabama and Southwest Feeder Cattle Marketing Association (S.A.F.E.) as a marketing consultant. The officers and members of S.A.F.E. manage and execute this board auction.
5. This board auction accepts bids from persons in attendance and by telephone communications. Anyone wishing to participate in the auction via telephone should contact John Moseley Jr., consultant (229-723-7070 Office or 229-308-6355 Cell) or Trip Moseley (229-308-6358) or Will Moseley (229-308-3452) or Joey Moseley (229-308-3720) before sale day to make arrangements.
6. The auction order is steers first, split loads in the middle, and heifers last. Within the sexes, the general auction order is larger and heavier lots first, smaller and lighter lots follow.
7. The auction determines the highest bidder for each lot. The highest bidder buys the lot, unless the consignor immediately exercises his/her "NO SALE" option. If a consignor elects to "NO SALE" his/her cattle, he/she agree to pay the highest bidder the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) per head for every animal offered in the lot (Due Sale Night). In addition, the consignor agrees to pay the Southeast Alabama and Southwest Georgia Feeder Cattle Marketing Association the sum of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per head for every animal offered in the lot.
8. Consignors will cut out none merchantable cattle. Before the auction, bidders shall notify a consignor of any "out cattle" in his/her lot by giving the individual ear tag numbers. Buyers cannot sort cattle on loading day.

General Information, Specific Terms and Conditions (Continued)

9. Consignors strive to list accurate weights for their cattle based on growth, current conditions and date of delivery. To protect both buyers and sellers against weight variances, the highest bidder of each lot has the option to buy those cattle with or without a price slide. The highest bidder immediately executes this option and announces his/her choice before the auction proceeds. The price slide operates to adjust the final bid price down for heavier cattle. The price slide goes into effect when the average pay weight (shrunk weight at load-out) exceeds the base weight. The adjustment rate of the price slide is eight (8) cents per pound (\$8/CWT) when cattle weigh 600 lbs or more, and the adjustment rate of the price slide is and all cattle weighing below 600 lbs is an adjustment rate of the price slide is ten (10) cents per pound (\$10/CWT).
10. The weighing of cattle on truck or carrier at the nearest legal scale is the method to gain the gross pay weight (actual weight). A gross and tare weight for each load is required. At load-out, a two percent (2%) pencil shrink of actual weight yields the final pay weight unless notified before sale. The individual weighing of each lot is required. Some farms have their own scale, where the cattle will be weighted on the ground with a three percent (3%) pencil shrink to calculate the net pay weight.
11. The seller and buyer negotiate the date and time for cattle load-out. There is no Sunday loading of cattle. In advance of loading cattle, a minimum of 48 hours notice is required to allow for proper arrangements. The listing and grouping of delivery dates will follow the auction.
12. Immediately following the auction, a binder fee of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) per head will consummate acceptance of sale price and terms of sale. Upon payment of binder fee, the seller and buyer exchange a signed, triplicate contract (one copy for the association). The balance of the sale is due after weighing cattle at load-out. The completion of financial transactions to the satisfaction of the seller is necessary before the loading any cattle.
13. Legal title for cattle passes from producer (seller) to the purchaser with the completion of all financial transactions satisfactory to the seller. Liability for cattle passes to purchaser or his/her carrier when cattle are loaded.
14. The Southeast Alabama / Southwest Georgia Feeder Cattle Marketing Association reserves the right to make additions, revisions and/or amendments to these terms and conditions. Official announcements made from the auction stand during the sale will supersede these listed terms and conditions.
